The Trust provides hospital services in South Tyneside and community health services in South Tyneside, Gateshead and Sunderland. All members are invited to attend the meeting and anyone wishing to become a member is also very welcome. Membership is free and is open to residents of all three areas who are over the age of 16. Members elect the Council of Governors and receive regular updates about the work of the Trust.
