Plea to Trust members to vote for public governors

South Tyneside NHS Foundation Trust is urging its members to use their vote to elect new public governors to represent the views of people in South Tyneside and Gateshead on the Council of Governors and have a say in future health services in the areas in which they live.

Voting packs will be sent to the home addresses of eligible members from Friday, November 13th. Electronic voting is being introduced for the first time to make it easier for them to cast their votes.

The Trust provides hospital services in South Tyneside and community health services in South Tyneside, Gateshead and Sunderland. It has three vacant posts for South Tyneside, for which there are nine candidates, and one for Gateshead, which two candidates are contesting. There are currently no vacancies in Sunderland so members living in that area will not be eligible to vote.
